Display of results, “Good New Assembly” and “Sports Award Assembly” creates a ‘buzz’ about sporting successes. Games lessons are timetabled as part of PPA and are therefore rarely cancelled. Spare PE kits have been purchased which also raises participation.	Sports Coach Salary	The quality and frequency of Games lessons is very high – as noted on a DHT and HT observation. Pupil participation has increased as a result. Sport Coach has begun a 6 year degree through the Open University to become a qualified teacher. Sept 2015-July 2020	Have appointed a apprentice Sports Coach to assist Coach Knowles. Therefore PPA sport is never cancelled due to inter-sports games. Also PPA lessons now benefit from 2 coaches giving input to the children.

This culminates in a half-termly sporting competition amongst the year groups where ALL children participate. The school council had received a number of complaints of boys dominating the Multi-Sports sessions at lunchtimes.</p> <p>Girls have participated in Inter School sports that included, football, tag-rugby, netball, rounders, basketball, cricket, hockey, cross country, tennis, swimming and handball.</p>	<p>Sports Coach's Salary</p>	<p>Participation in sports during games lessons has increased.
